



### Fig.1 Grounded Emitter Propagation Characteristics




Fig.2 Typical Output Characteristics

Fig.3 DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current (I)



Fig.5 Collector-Emitter Saturation





Fig.7 Base-Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current








Fig.6 Collector-Emitter Saturation

Fig.8 Gain Bandwidth Product vs. Emitter Current




